AT A GLANCE IN 2013

- 935 students received scholarship grants totaling \$1.4 million; 20 of these students were dependents of officers killed in the line of duty (Fallen Heroes).
- **Fallen Hero Scholarships** totaled \$167,600.
- Average grant award was \$1,500.
- **Sullivan Advanced Study Scholarship**, a new program was introduced in 2013 because of the generosity of 11-99 members, Suzanne and Godfrey Sullivan. Their gift allowed 27 high-achieving students to receive scholarships ranging from \$5,000 to \$25,000.

AT A GLANCE IN 2014

- A generous multi-year gift was provided by the Automobile Club of Southern California that will provide extra funding to the scholarship program for many years into the future.
- We anticipate receiving more than 1,000 scholarship applications from eligible students.
- \$1.6 million will be provided in scholarship grants.
- We will again be providing multiple scholarships under the Advanced Study Scholarship program, with the top student receiving a \$25,000 grant.
